English	Practise reading the Year 1 common exception words.	Choose 3 different common exception words, can you put them into sentences remembering your capital letters, finger spaces and full stops?	Create an alternative front cover for your favourite book.	Thinking about suffix endings 'ed' and 'ing', can you put these words into sentences: Jumped/ jumping Splashed/ splashing Played/ playing
Topic (Independent)	Practise throwing and catching. You could use a variety of different sized balls or maybe even a balloon! Which is easier/ harder to throw and catch. Can you move around while throwing the ball up and catching it?	Create a pictogram to show information you've collected at home. This could be favourite animal or colours of Lego bricks in a pile! Record using a tally and then use a picture to represent your data.	Springtime scavenger hunt. Go outdoors! What signs of spring can you see? Can you identify any leaves or flowers that you spot?	Compare and contrast means of communication in Britain during the time of the First World War with communication today.
