Maths	Practice reading and writing numbers from 0 - 20 in numerals and words.	Create a number line starting at 10 and finishing at 20.	Roll a dice, can you count the number of spots and work out what 'double' the number of spots would be?	Write down the number bonds to 20.
English	Practise reading the Year 1 common exception words.	Practise writing the descenders - long letters - q, y, p, f, g, j,	Choose 3 different common exception words, can you put them into sentences remembering your capital letters, finger spaces and full stops?	Research and write some information about how penguins and how they have adapted to their environment.
Topic (Independent)	Using a map, globe or an online platform, can you locate Antarctica?	Can you create a piece of artwork looking at the landscape of Antarctica? What colours can you see? What different textures can you create in your artwork?	Describe and explain the components of the food chain of an Emperor Penguin	Investigate Why don't Ostriches need to fly? This will run alongside our work on penguins and involve finding out about how ostriches live (their food, their nests and how their chicks hatch out of eggs).
