The Circulatory System





Inside the Small Intestine

The **nutrients** pass through the **villi** and are absorbed into the blood vessels.

Water is absorbed in the small intestine in exactly the same way as other **nutrients** are absorbed.

Blood transports:

- gases (mostly oxygen and carbon dioxide);
- nutrients** (including water);
- waste products.
