English	Practise reading the Year 1 common exception words (red words). Test yourself - how many do you know?	Choose 5 of the Year 1 common exception words (red words) to practise writing.	Create an alternative front cover for your favourite book. Can you discuss why this is your favourite story?	Write two sentences about your house - what road do you live on, what type of house do you live in, who lives nearby?
Topic (Independent)	Practise your ball control - can you throw and catch a ball with someone in your house? Can you throw the ball up in the air and catch it when it returns? Can you bounce the ball on the floor and catch it after?	Make a model of your house. (You could use lego, play-doh, building blocks...)	Go on a material hunt around your house. Can you find something: Shiny Bumpy Rough Smooth Soft Make a list of the items and what they are made out of.	Create a map of your journey to school.
