Topic (Independent)	Go on a nature walk and find some different rock types. See if you can identify if they are sedimentary, metamorphic or igneous.	Have a look at some different British fossils online. Draw your favourite and explain why you chose it.	Research Stone Age Art and then create your own version of prehistoric art.	Draw a picture of a significant monument from the Stone Age and label the different parts of it.
