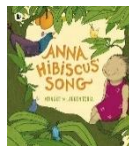
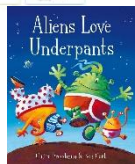
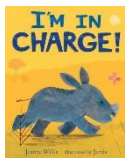
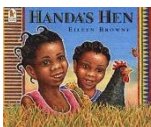


Literacy: Reading and Writing

- Recap Set 1 single letter sounds and set 1 'special friends.'
- Learn/recap Set 2 sounds
- Read red words (red/green level)
- Recap and practice the correct letter formation
- Write CVC words using their 'Fred Fingers.'
- Independently use a sound mat to help them identify which sounds they need to spell a word.
- Write phonetically decodable words, phrases, captions and sentences



Communication and Language

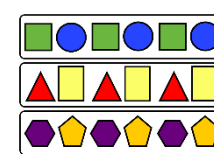
- Listen to and talk about stories to build familiarity and understanding.
- Engage in non-fiction books.
- Listen to and talk about selected non-fiction to develop a deep familiarity with new knowledge and vocabulary.
- Continue to widen vocabulary during 'Talk Through Stories'



Enrichments: Library Visit

Maths

- Use subitising skills to enable them to identify when patterns show the same number but in a different arrangement, or when patterns are similar but have a different number.
- Subitise structured and unstructured patterns, including those which show numbers within 10, in relation to 5 and 10.
- Be encouraged to identify when it is appropriate to count and when groups can be subitised.
- Explore the composition of 10.
- Order sets of objects, linking this to their understanding of the ordinal number system.
- Identify and continue a pattern



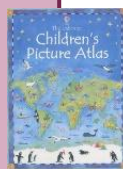
Expressive Arts and Design
