Communication and Language

To develop communication when responding and interacting with an adult or a peer

- To use some Makaton signs
- Begin to imitate and use gestures, sounds or simple words to communicate
- To use PECs or coreboard to request wanted item
- To communicate likes and dislikes with signs or symbols
- To develop pretend play
- Can ask for help using their individual methods.
- Follow simple instructions
- Allow adults or peers to play alongside me.
- Follow Speech and Language programme set by Speech and Language Therapist
- To continue to develop speech skills as directed by speech and language therapist/ outlined in communication support plan.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Settles into class.
- Builds positive relationships with peers.
- Is happy to join an activity
- Will accept help
- Can ask for help
- Shows an understanding of simple feeling words eg. happy/ sad

Literacy

- Responds to a visuals

Physical Development
