STRONGLY AGREE: 89% AGREE: 9%
- All families feel welcomed and included. **96%**
STRONGLY AGREE: 83% AGREE: 13%
- Staff engage with parents/carers in a variety of ways on a day-to-day basis. **91%**
STRONGLY AGREE: 78% AGREE: 13%
- The school provides regular opportunities to celebrate success in academic and wider outcomes
