Maths	Practice the times tables you need to move up to the next country on our 'Around the World Challenge'.	Complete the My Maths activity set.	Practise the current KIRF and show me your learning in your homework book. (Key Instant Recall Facts are in class Information on Website)	Write some multiplication and division fact families. There should be four number sentences in each family.
English	Would our lives be different if there were no shadows? Explain what might be good and bad about it.	Write a story which includes light and shadow. It could be a spooky story in moonlight.	Research and write about Florida. What would you visit if you went there?	Write a diary entry child the same age as you that has just joined our class. What might they find strange? How might they feel?
Topic (Independent)	Create or find online an experiment about light and shadow. Explain what the experiment is and record your results. What does it show us?	Draw a map of Florida and mark on some of the famous locations.	Create a table comparing Florida and Cornwall. It could have all sorts of things on it (size, weather, population etc.)	Create a picture that uses light and shadow on J2E. It could be on Logo or Jit5.
